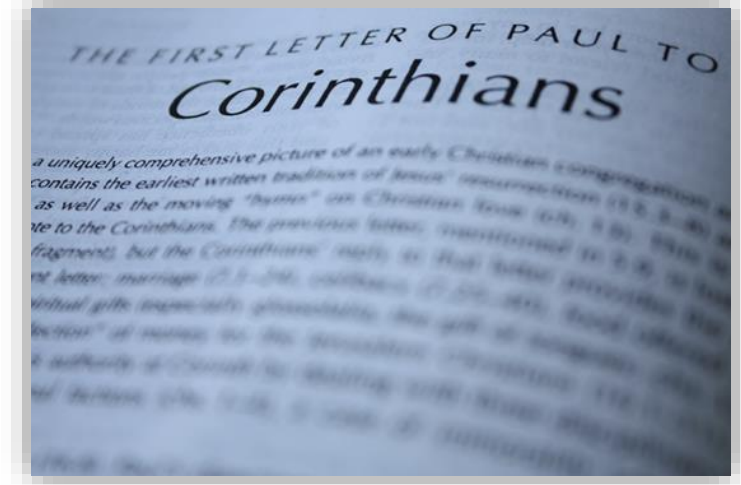


## ***Personal Application and Conversations***

We will be wrapping up our mini-series on spiritual gifts today. Have you stopped to think about a spiritual gift you've seen in one of your friends here at Calvary? Have you thanked God for the gift He has given you and asked Him to show you fresh ways you can use it to build up our church? I hope we who are followers of Jesus know for certain that He has equipped us all to serve one another in love so that His work prospers. The Greek word for a "spiritual gift" is **charisma**. That means we are a church with lots of *charisma*. That's right. And charisma comes from the word, **charis**, the Biblical word for grace. The word for "joy" is **chara**, which is also translated "delight" or "gladness". So, when we use our gifts, we experience real joy.
